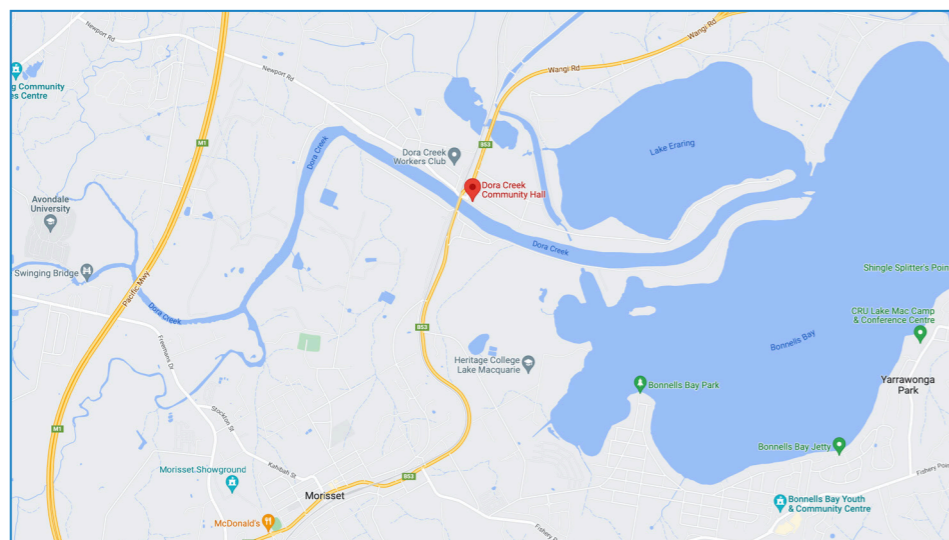
So if you're finding one topic doesn't overly interest you, hang in there, as another topic will be about to take over.
